If you or any adult 18 years or older residing in your home have been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one of these offenses and the offense was a misdemeanor, three years must have elapsed from the date you were fully discharged from any imprisonment or probation arising from the conviction.

If you or any adult 18 years or older residing in your home have been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one of these offenses and the offense was a felony, ten years must have elapsed from the date you were fully discharged from any imprisonment or probation arising from the conviction.
